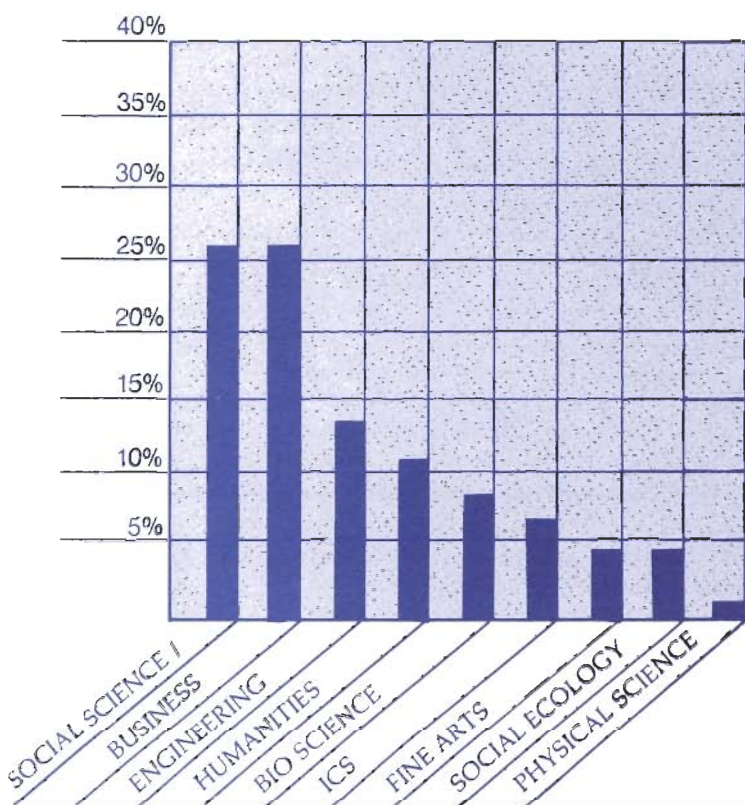

Profile of Respondents

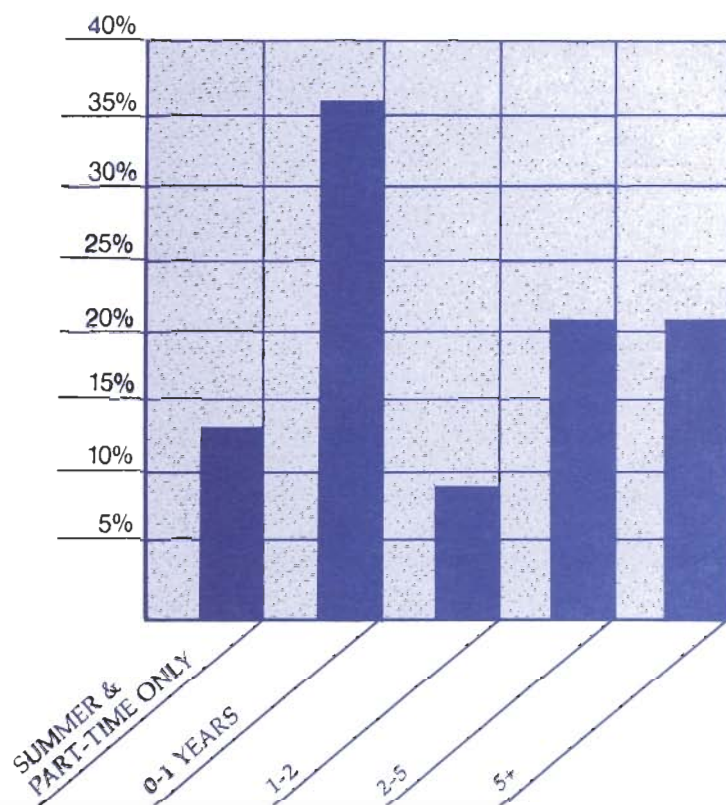

Number of years of full-time work experience prior to graduation. (Full-time is defined as 35 or more hours of work for 45 or more weeks in a calendar year.)

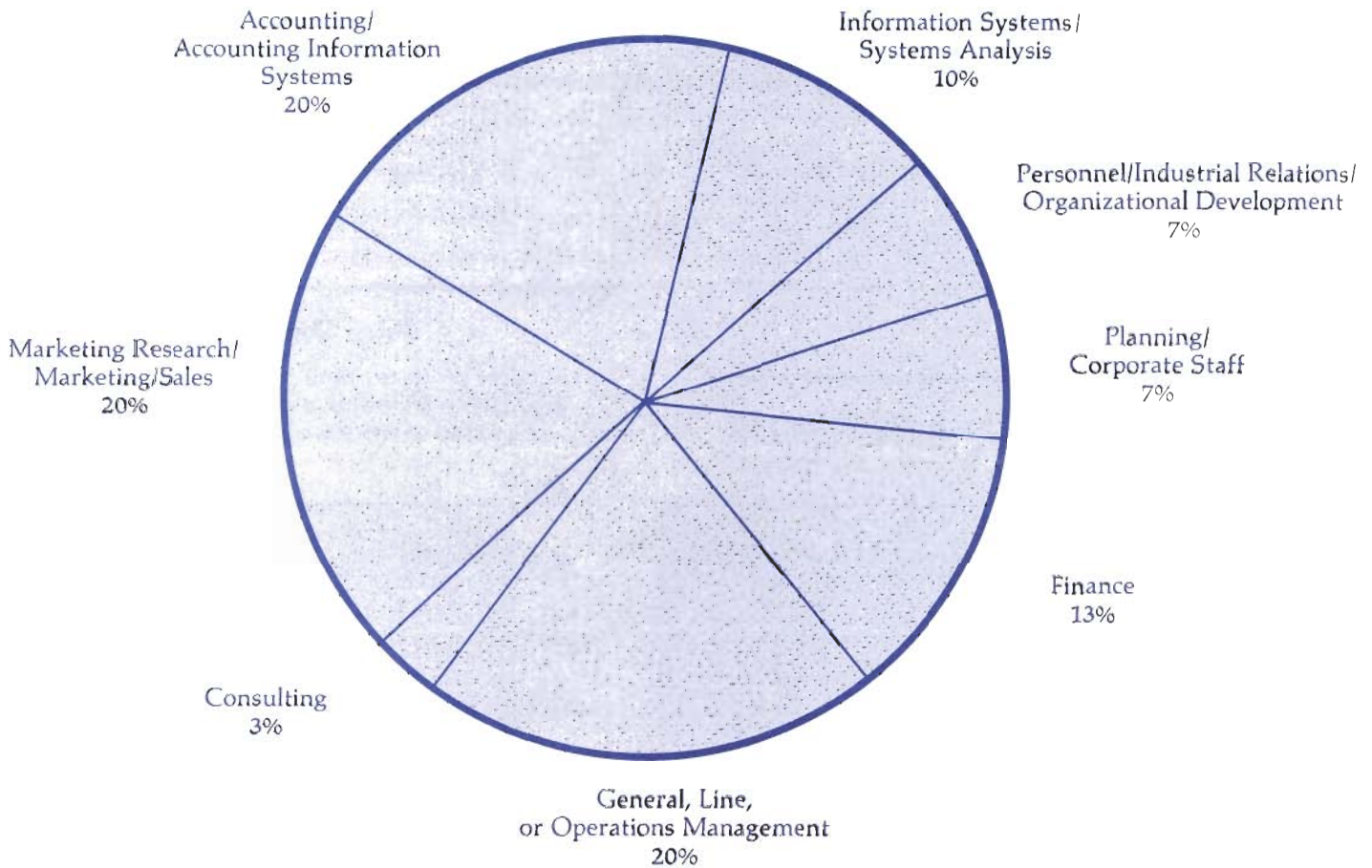
