CARRER PLANNING NOTES BY LINDA HEINTZ

All second year students should have received guidelines for writing their resumes for the GSM Resume Book in the mail. If you did not receive the guidelines, let me know and I will give you a copy.

I would like to include all of you who will be finishing up by June in the Resume Book, even those of you who are already employed. The Resume Book is sent out to selected employers and will help you establish job leads.

I will be conducting a workshop on resume preparation on 10/9 from 12-1 pm and on 10/14 from 4-5 pm. Please sign up in room 323. During these workshops, I will answer questions on format and will critique resumes.

I want to encourage those of you who will be graduating in June to participate in the on-campus interviewing program. Most recruiters come in the Fall & Winter Quarters. Very few come in the Spring, so even though June seems far away, you need to be planning for it now; to be afert to what's going on. Check with me or with the placement center to obtain a recruitment schedule. Before you can sign up for an on-campus interview, you must attend an orientation with me at GSM or at the placement center.

If you would like to gain relevant work experience while going through the program, stop by my office to fill out a registration card so that I can assist you with your placement efforts.

I would like to get to know all of you personally. Stop by and see me in room 323. My drop in hours are Mondays 10:30 - 12:30 and Wednesdays 3:00-5:00.

By the way, you must sign up at the placement center to attend the Mock interview session on 16 Oct. This will be a videotaped Mock interview exercise so come prepared.
